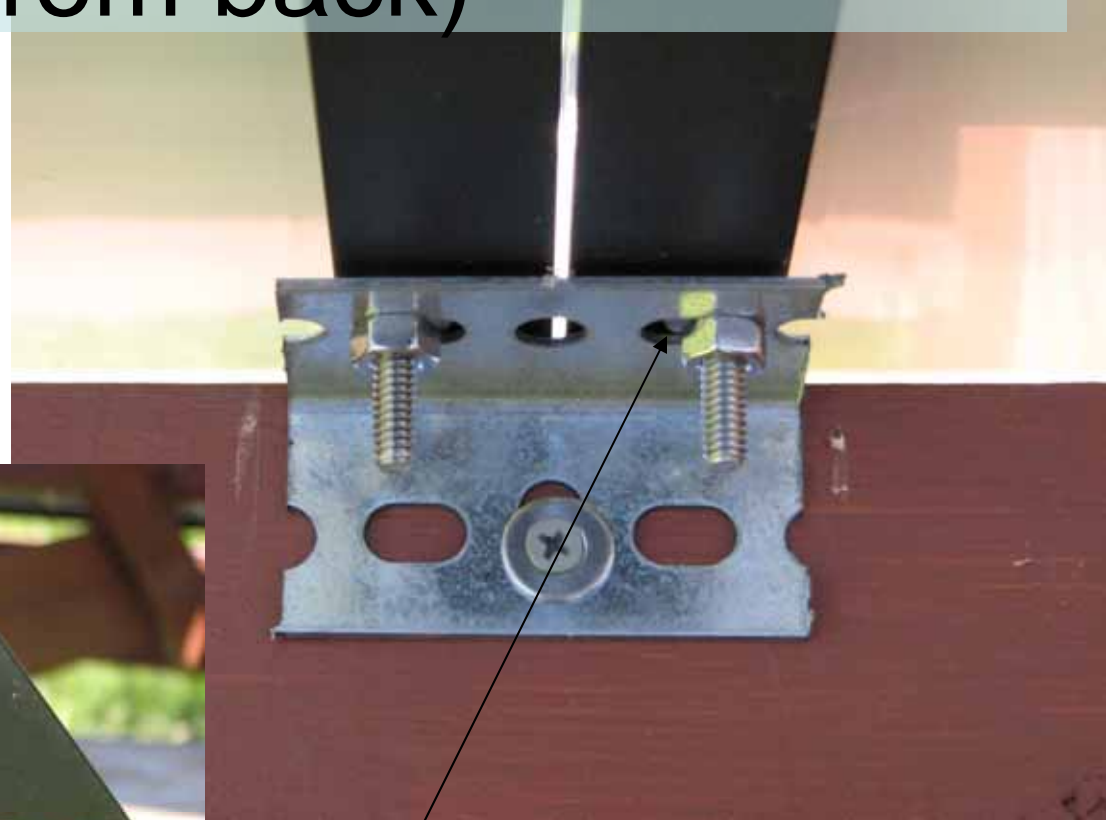
Finished Mounting Panels
